## From The Pastor's Pen...



It's that time of year again in the life & ministry of Mount Calvary! This month we are celebrating Men Ministry and Thanksgiving.

At Mount Calvary, we take time to celebrate our men because it is our opportunity to emphasize, affirm and lift the priesthood of our men in church and community. This year the Men's Month theme is "Walking in the Empowerment of Christ." Our Annual Men's Day Celebration will be held on Sunday, November 17. Come and share as we inspire, challenge and motivate the need for men's involvement in the Message,

Ministry and Mission of the church to make a difference in the lives of others.

Lastly, as we approach the Thanksgiving season, we understand we live in a world where people have a different way of looking at life. Oft times they become trapped in a mindset that says: Get all you can and keep it for yourself. But as Christians, we are called to think biblically and reject worldly philosophies that lead us away from God. That's why generosity is so important; it challenges us to think and act contrary to worldly beliefs and rely instead on what the Lord says in His Word. Allow me to lift several reasons as to why we should be generous.

First, we should be generous because God is generous. "He Himself gives to all people life and breath and all things" (Acts 17:25). There is nothing stingy about God. Second, we should be generous because God is our sufficiency. Our hope is not in the uncertainty of riches but in the Lord who richly supplies us with all things to enjoy (1 Tim. 6:17). With this truth as our foundation there's no reason to cling tightly to wealth or possession. Third, we should be generous because God's ways are best. Although the world promotes the accumulation of wealth, true riches aren't measured by material or financial abundance but by spiritual riches. God says, "He who trusts in his riches will fall, but the righteous will flourish like the green leaf" (v. 28). Fourth, we should be generous because God uses generosity to conform us into Christ's image. Liberality weans us from love of the world and its pleasures and pursuits and frees us to serve Christ. Jesus warned that no one can serve two masters—God and wealth—for he will hate one and love the other (Matt. 6:24).

Our generosity contributes to the ministry and mission of the church by displaying Christ's love to a watching world and showing His power to change us. Generosity is a selfless lifestyle that is God-focused and other-centered. Contrary to what the world says, there is more joy to be found in giving with the right heart than in accumulating more for ourselves.

It is my prayer as you gather around the Thanksgiving table, I hope you and your family will take a moment to reflect upon what you are grateful for and give.
